How to use our playstation console

**TURNING

TURNING ON

CONSOLE

Open the small cabinet on the bottom left of the television.

Take out a controller and press the button in the centre of the controller with the Playstation logo on it.

This turns on the console. It is on if the light on the back of the controller is blue or the light strip on the console is blue/white.

If this doesn't work press the top button on the console itself.



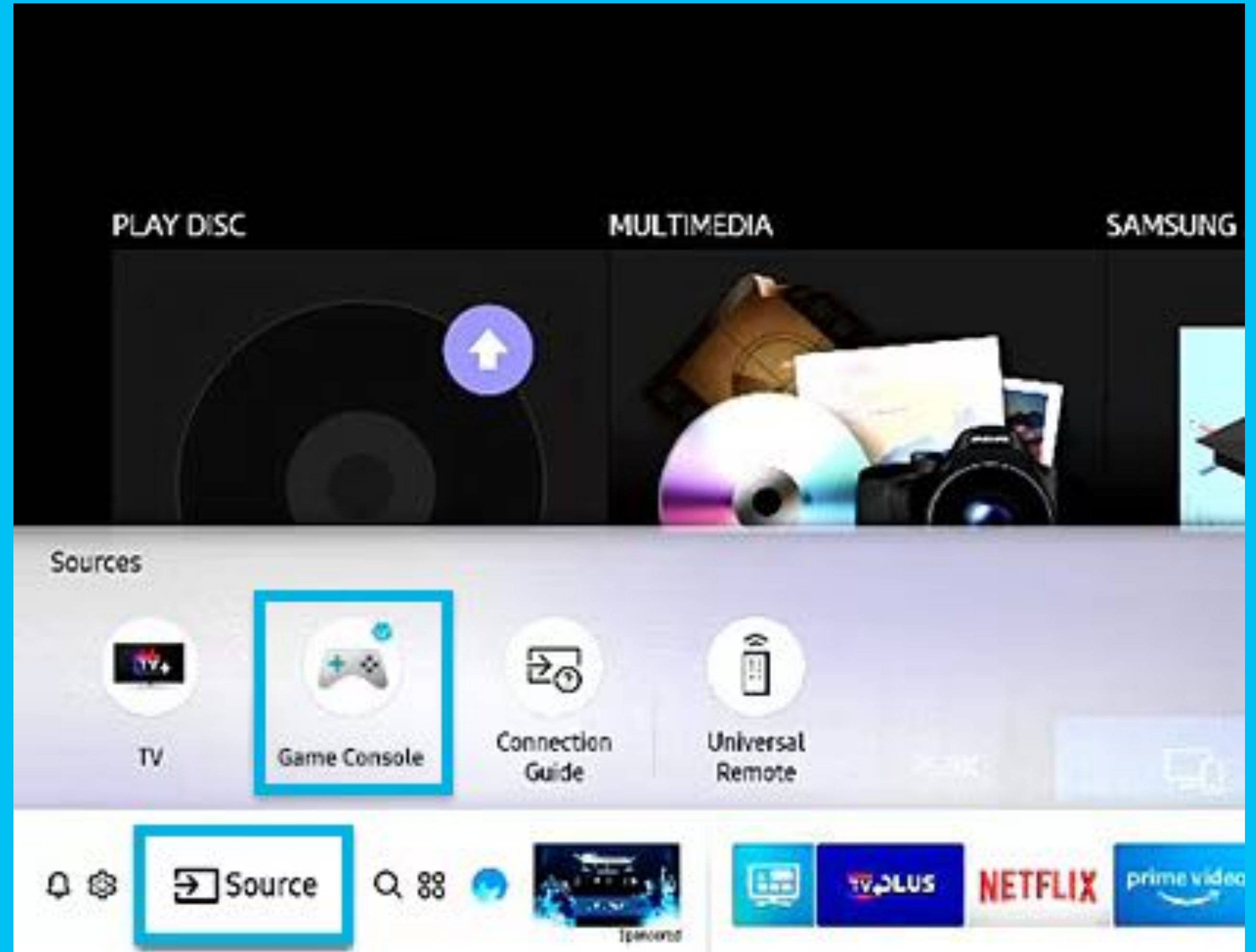

Then turn on the television with the TV remote as you would normally.

On the home menu of the TV go to the icon dubbed Playstation (usually on the far right or HDMI 4) using the ring on the TV remote.

Press enter with the button in the centre of the ring.

You are then presented with the Playstation user selection.

You can use the F42-One and the F42-Two accounts.

Don't use the Graham Lancashire account (It is also secured with a password).

To select an account press the X-button on the Playstation controller.

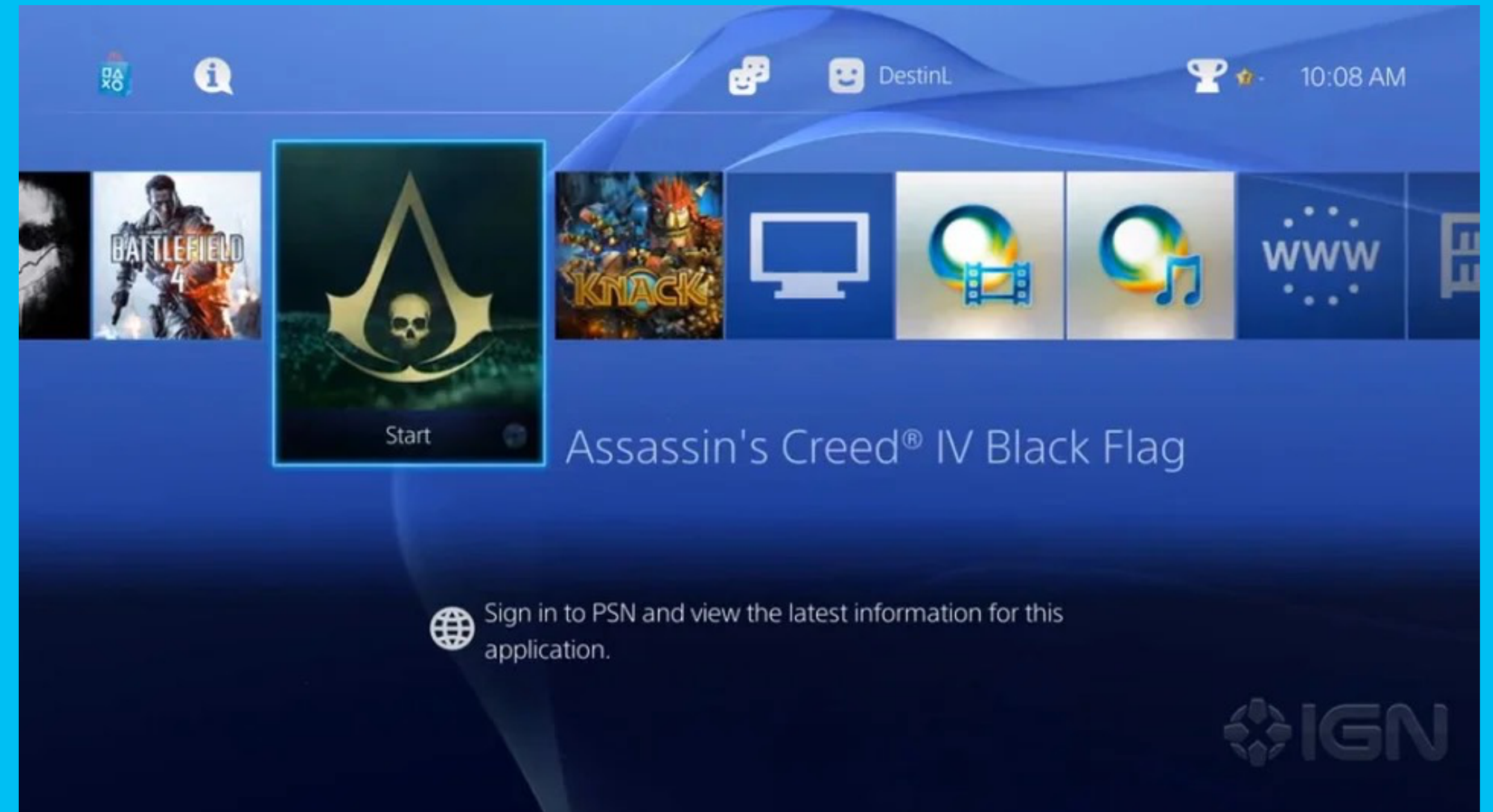

You are then greeted by the Playstation home screen. There you will find the most recently played games.

For the full list of games go to the far right using the left joystick. There you will find the library.

Press the X-button and you will be presented by a list of all the games.

When you are done playing hold down the the button in the centre of the controller with the Playstation logo on it.

A menu should pop up. Head to the power section and select the option rest mode.

Then place the controller back on the middle shelf in the cabinet. Always plug it in.

The cable is connected to the right side of the console. Turn of the TV.
